In conjunction with local associations, Bordeaux Métropole encourages social and solidarity-based projects, as well as itineraries that make the most of the refuges in the suburbs: solidarity-based tourism, unusual vacations for out-of-towners, hikes to discover the city with an overnight stopover in a refuge... Social, solidarity or sports associations, cultural centers, activity centers... if you'd like to offer an unusual outing to your public, we can coordinate the pre-booking of your nights in a Refuge. A camping kit (comforters, lamps, water bottles, etc.) can also be lent to associations developing projects





with a social vocation.
