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Chinese Table Tennis College – Europe in Luxembourg (CTTCE)

Nature:

A non-profit organization devoted to table tennis training, education with formal schooling and scientific research.

Objectives:

To become the center of table tennis training, education and scientific research in Europe.

Functions:

1) To carry out various types and levels of trainings, including training of youth, coaches as well as referees;

2) To offer university academic education programs, including bachelor, master and doctoral programs, for example, table tennis oriented programs in physical education, sports training or teacher cultivation;

3) To conduct researches and academic exchanges, including researches in competitive and healthy table tennis science as well as table tennis market, management and competition.

Operation Model:

CTTA, CTTC, FLTT, Luxembourg University, a European Training Center and sponsors shall cooperate to organize a management committee to discuss and decide training, teaching, scientific research, finance and other major matters of the CTTCE:

1) to send outstanding coaches as lecturers of various types and levels of trainings, and to send elite players for trainings together with European players, jointly improving table tennis technical levels;

2) to send teachers to teach professional courses of table tennis, to send professors as instructors of graduates (MA, PhD);

3) to offer scholarships of CTTC which gives the opportunities to learn and participate in Chinese table tennis league

4) to jointly promote research projects and regularly hold academic seminars;

5) To offer table tennis teaching and training materials (Chinese organization will do the translation from Chinese into English).

Major responsibilities of European Partners

1) To be responsible for a variety of training enrolment, organization, coordination and management;

2) to be responsible for providing training facilities, accommodations for coaches and players sent by the CTTC, but a teacher who undertakes table tennis courses teaching at university needs to borne meals and accommodation by himself;

3) to establish table tennis education degree programs (Bachelor, Master, PhD), enroll students in Europe or worldwide, and work together with China to set down teaching programs etc.;

4) to select and send outstanding undergraduate and graduate students to have learning and training in China.

5) to conduct scientific research jointly and hold international academic seminars regularly.

Work plan:

1) to hold trainings for different levels of European players three to four times each year, with the training session of 2 or 3 weeks each time.

Coach trainings are also to be conducted during the training period.

2) to conduct collaboration through work of CTTCE n areas of student/faculty exchanges, credit transfers and research projects between CTTCE and European partner universities; to cooperate in cultivation of elite table tennis talents.

3) CTTCE and European partner universities work together to establish table tennis oriented programs in physical education, sports training or teacher training in physical education and to recruit bachelor, master and doctoral candidates in Europe or worldwide. The European partner universities shall give full support to ensure qualified table tennis players to study in CTTCE and enjoy the same treatment in tuition fee, registration and dormitory as international students in other majors.

4) to hold annually a table tennis international seminar, with a scale of 30 to 50 peoples.
