Spring term 2016 - more than 340 courses at the Institut national des langues (INL)

Enrollment for spring term courses at the INL, the largest language school for adults in the Greater Region, is open. The INL course offer includes general language courses for beginners and non-beginners, as well as specific objectives courses from level A1 to C1.

The classes start on February 24th, 2016.

INL-Kirchberg offers courses in German, English, Chinese, Spanish, French, Italian, Portuguese and Luxembourgish, whereas at the INL-Mersch the course offer is limited to Luxembourgish, French and English.

During this spring term, our afternoon and evening courses in English, German, Portuguese and Spanish will take place at Lycée Aline Mayrisch – Forum Geeseknëppchen.

The frequency of courses varies from one to three times a week and each lesson lasts 100 minutes. Classes start at 8:10 am, 10:10 am, 12:10 pm, 2:10 pm, 3:15 pm 5:15 pm and 7:10 pm CET.

Registration fees vary between 100 and 175 Euro per term, depending on course frequency.

Anyone can register by filling in the online application form at <u>www.inll.lu</u> and paying a €10 administration fee. The candidate will then be invited for an assessment test and interview, the aim of which it is to identify the course level most appropriate for the needs and capabilities of the future student. The assessment test appointment dates are on February 15th and 16th and will take place at INL-Kirchberg.

Important: Receiving an appointment does not automatically mean enrollment for a course!
