B. Accreditation

1. Accreditation

Media representatives wishing to cover the 134th Session of the Committee of Ministers **must submit an accreditation request** to the Information and Press Service of the Luxembourg Government (SIP).

• Accreditation expiration date

Accreditation requests must be submitted by 9 May 2025 at the latest. Any requests deemed incomplete or submitted after this date will not be accepted.

Accreditation expiration date

Friday 09.05.2025 at 02.00 pm

• Accreditation procedure

Accreditation applications may **only** be made **online** via the <u>accreditation portal</u> for media representatives.

The portal is managed by the Information and Press Service of the Luxembourg Government (SIP).

• Accreditation badge / badge collection

Your accreditation badge must be collected **in person** and is **non-transferable**.

The badge must be worn visibly. Any loss of an accreditation badge must be reported immediately to the accreditation desk.

When collecting your accreditation badge, you must present both following documents :

- a valid identity document (passport or identity card) with photo;
- your press card or, for those without a press card, the assignment letter

D. Press Centre – European Convention Center Luxembourg (ECCL)

1. Press Centre

The press centre set in place for the 134th Session of the Committee of Ministers is located at the European Convention Centre Luxembourg (ECCL).

The ECCL is located in Kirchberg, in the northeast of Luxembourg City, 2 km from the city centre, 5 km from the central train station and 8 km from Luxembourg airport.

The press centre, set up within the ECCL, includes a large working area with 470 workstations and audiovisual editing booths. Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi) is available throughout the press centre.


1. Site access – Wednesday 14 May 2025

The media entrance is located on Rue du Fort Thüngen.

Accreditation is compulsory for all media representatives wishing to access the ECCL and use its facilities. Access is subject to presentation of the documents required for accreditation and a security check.
